FROM THE PRINCIPAL . . .

For the next several days, the Church will be in mourning for the passing of Pope Francis. Shortly following this, there will be the gathering of the Cardinals called a *conclave* - certain Bishops from around the world that were chosen especially for this task - that will meet in Rome to pray for guidance from the Holy Spirit and select a new Pope.

Why is this such a big deal in the Catholic Church? Primarily because we believe that Our Lord gave a special ministry to St. Peter and his successors (the Bishops of Rome = Popes) which we see established in the Gospel of St. Matthew. In Chapter 16, Jesus says, "... you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my Church and the powers of death shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven . . ." This ministry of the "keys" is that of a Prime Minister (or Vicar - substitute/representative) to lead in the care of the people while the King is away (see also Isaiah 22:22). In this passage is also something that is called the "indefectibility" of the Church. This means that Jesus - the King of kings - promises to keep the Church which is in the custody of St. Peter and his successors in existence until He returns at the end of time.

What does Rome have to do with Peter? Rome - the capital city of the Gentile world - is the city where St. Peter was the first Bishop and where he died. Also, The Book of Acts, the book which documents the spread of the Gospel in the early Church, begins in Jerusalem, but ends in Rome. This signifies that the Gospel is not simply a "Jewish" thing, but is Good News for the whole world. So in these days leading up to the selection of a new Pope, we especially pray that Our Lord will continue to fulfill His promises and will continue to guide, protect, and inspire the Church to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
